Season's greetings from the Circus Historical Society!

As 2024 ends, we would like to take this opportunity to bring you up to date you about recent activities at the CHS and to give you a heads-up about what we have planned for 2025.

Since our last edition of *The Advance Car*, we have published another highly acclaimed issue of our *Bandwagon* journal. We also produced two more *Circus History Live!* programs. One showcased circus artist, author, and speaker Dave "Letterfly" Knoderer, and the other session featured two 1990s-era Ringling Red Unit alumni: clown Nicole Portwood and publicist Rom Portwood. Recordings of these programs plus six new *Circus History Spotlight* interviews are now available on the <u>CHS</u> YouTube Channel.

We also posted over sixty new circus history items on the <u>CHS Facebook Page</u> and hosted over eleven hundred posts in the <u>CHS Facebook Group</u>. Thanks to your participation, our extremely active CHS Facebook Group has now grown to over thirteen thousand five hundred members!

During the same period, five CHS members shared their knowledge of circus history on the radio and in academic and filmmaking settings. Next month, about twenty members from four countries will travel to Monte-Carlo to participate in the activities of the Federation Mondial du Cirque, of which the Circus Historical Society is an associate member. And, in November 2025, many more of our members will gather in Las Vegas for our exciting annual convention.

All these activities are the result of the collective efforts of our officers, trustees, and members who generously volunteer their time, talents, and treasure to help us preserve circus history. If you would like to volunteer as well, see the Volunteers Wanted section below for new opportunities.

Digital-Only Bandwagon Option

Based on feedback from members, *Bandwagon* is now available in both printed and digital-only formats.

Print - This is the default option for those who prefer receiving a printed copy of *Bandwagon* via mail. Members who receive a print copy also have access to digital copies from the previous three years via the members only Back Yard website. Members who want to keep receiving a printed copy of *Bandwagon* by mail do not need to take any action.

Digital-Only - This is the option for members who have expressed interest in no longer receiving a printed copy of *Bandwagon* via mail, preferring to read it online via their computer or mobile device. With this option, you will <u>not</u> receive a paper copy of *Bandwagon*, but will be notified via email when the new issue is available each quarter on the members only Back Yard website as a PDF.

Members who want to switch to digital-only can log on to their Profile on the <u>CHS Back Yard website</u> with their email address and password, click the *Edit Profile* button, and select the *Digital Bandwagon Only* field.



The CHS Thayer Prize Committee is now accepting nominations for the 2025 Thayer Prize. Only Circus Historical Society members in good standing are eligible to make nominations. Members may nominate one or more works, including their own. Click here for additional information.

Only non-fictional works published, issued, or released during 2023 and 2024 are eligible for nomination for the 2025 prize. Members must submit nominations on either the *official online form* or the *official mail-in form*. Full eligibility criteria and nomination forms are available on the Thayer Prize page on the members-only CHS Back Yard site. Members can log on to the <u>CHS Back Yard site</u> with their email address and password.

The deadline for submission is March 31, 2025.




2024 Donations
